1 Which bus stop is after La Fouly heading for Ferret?

- (1) Ferret (3) L'Amónaz

2 Look at this big building on the right. La Fouly is the main resort in the:

- (1) Val d'Entremont (3) Val d'Arpette
(2) Val Ferret (4) Val de Bagnes

3 There's a board at the end of the big parking area. Which activities are not on there?

- (1) Scooters (3) Ziplines
(2) Treetop canopy (4) Climbing wall

4 You're in front of the containment basin with a big wall on your right. This looks like a:
